Minutes of the meeting of the Community Wellbeing Committee held on Thursday 15th July 2021 commencing at 19:00 hrs

CW 143. Chair's Announcements

The Chair announced that there had been reports for people cycling around the tight corner by the Higher Mill Footpath and ways of making this path safer were being looked at. In addition, the Chair reminded everyone about the Peninsula Transport consultation which would be on the Town Council agenda.

CW 144. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Andrews and Guest.

CW 150. Public Rights of Way

Cullompton's Volunteer Footpath Warden gave an oral report which included:

- The annual parish walks programme is underway and operating in accordance with government guidelines
- There have been complaints about the re-instatement of the surface in Goblin Lane following recent works by a utility company
- There have been complaints about the footpath between the Bell Inn and Crow Green being overgrown
- The Footpath alongside the Leat is a public footpath and therefore there is no right to ride a bicycle along it; advice is being sought from Devon County Council about preventative measures.

CW 151. Cullompton's Garden Trail/Best Garden Competition

Consideration was given to the Town Council facilitating a Garden Trail/Competition (Supporting Paper E to the Agenda).

The Town Clerk was asked to bring this forward in October / November 2021 with a view to it being included in the Committee's next 3 year workplan.
